Get PAID \$1200 to make a difference in your community! Apply for a 4 week PREVENTION internship!

The Eastern Washington Area Health Education Center (EWAHEC), Washington State Health Care Authority Division of Behavioral Health, the Washington State Department of Health and the Community Prevention and Wellness Initiative (CPWI) are offering high school students the opportunity to participate in a parttime 4 week internship.

Intern Requirements:

- Must be 16 or older at the time of internship
- Must live near your chosen CPWI internship site
- Must intern 15 hours per week for 4 weeks (60 total hours)
- Preference is given to black, indigenous, people of color (BIPOC) or students from low-income families (200% of FPL or less)

Internship is 15 hours per week for 4 weeks (60 total hours)

Interns will receive a \$1200 stipend for completing, uniform polo shirts, and mileage or transportation costs to their internship site. Most work will be done remotely from the interns home. COVID restrictions will be observed and PPE will be provided
